1. File is placed before this Court vide order dated 13.02.2026 for recording the statement of the parties.
2. Petitioners seek quashing of case FIR No. 266/2025 of PS Shakarpur for offence under Section 110/351(2)/3(5) BNS on the ground that the complainants de facto (respondents no. 2 and 3) have compromised the disputes with the petitioners.

5. Investigating Officer is present in Court and has duly verified the identity of the petitioners and R-2. Separate statement of Investigating Officer has also been recorded.

6. Learned counsel for R-2 and 3 seeks an adjournment to ensure the presence of R-3 on the next date of hearing for recording the statement. Heard. Allowed.
