Ministry of Transport and Highways is under challenge, however, no affidavit in reply on behalf of Union of India has been filed. The counter affidavit by National Highway Authority of India has been filed.

2. Let clear instructions be sought by learned counsel representing the Union of India as to whether the Union of India shall adopt the counter affidavit filed by NHAI or it intends to file a separate counter affidavit. In case, a separate affidavit is to be filed by the Union of India, the same shall be done within two weeks. Two weeks thereafter shall be available to the petitioner to file the rejoinder affidavit, if any. Rejoinder affidavit to the counter affidavit already filed by NHAI be also filed within two weeks.
