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1. Heard the learned counsel for the parties.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has brought to the notice of the Court a Division Bench judgment of High Court of Punjab and Haryana rendered on 20.03.2025 in CWP-19799/2023 connected with CWP-8072/2024 “***Sohan Lal and Others Vs. Union of India and Others***” whereby provisions of Section 3G and 3J of the National Highways Act, 1956 have been declared to be unconstitutional and consequently void.
3. The prayer made in the writ petition is that Section 3G (5) of the said Act



be declared as unconstitutional. However, the said order of the High Court of Punjab and Haryana has been challenged before the Hon'ble Supreme Court SLP (C) no. 14758/2025 where Hon'ble Supreme Court by means of an order dated 30.05.2025 has stayed the operation of the judgment passed by the Punjab and Haryana High Court.

4. Accordingly, we find it appropriate to adjourn the proceedings of this writ petition *sine die* which shall resume once the matter pending before the Hon'ble Supreme Court is decided.

5. The matter is adjourned *sine die*.

6. Learned counsel for the parties shall inform the Court as and when the matter before the Hon'ble Supreme Court is decided.
