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ORDER

1. As per service report, Defendant No. 1 stands served on 12.03.2026, whereas Defendant Nos. 2 to 7 remain unserved.
2. As per the service reports in respect of Defendant Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5, the process server met their nephew at the given address, who refused to accept the summons stating that the said defendants were not at home.
3. In respect of Defendant Nos. 6 and 7, it has been reported that a person met the process server at the given address and stated that Defendant Nos. 6 and 7 are his sisters and are not residing at the said address and, therefore, he refused to accept the summons.



4. Learned counsel for the plaintiff prays for one more attempt to serve Defendant Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 at the same address along with dasti service.
5. In respect of Defendant Nos. 6 and 7, time is sought for locating their fresh addresses.
6. Accordingly, let Defendant Nos. 2, 3, 4 and 5 be served through all permissible modes at the same address. Dasti service is also permitted as prayed.
7. Time is granted to the plaintiff to locate fresh addresses of Defendant Nos. 6 and 7.
8. Thereafter, let Defendant Nos. 6 and 7 be served at the fresh addresses, if located, through all permissible modes.
9. Learned counsel for Defendant No. 1 submits that two pages are missing from the application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 CPC and prays for directions to learned counsel for the plaintiff to supply the same.
10. Learned counsel for the plaintiff objects and submits that complete set of the plaint along with paper book has already been supplied.
11. Be that as it may, let fresh copy of the application under Order XXXIX Rules 1 and 2 CPC be supplied to learned counsel for Defendant No. 1 today itself through WhatsApp or email.
12. It is made clear that the Court is not making any observation regarding effect of fresh supply of application under Order XXXIX Rule 1 & 2 CPC on the date of service.
13. Let pleadings be completed, as per Rules, qua the defendants already served.
