1. By way of the present application, the applicant has raised a plea thereby contending that at the time of commission of the offence, he was a juvenile as his date of birth is 21.04.1982 and the date of incident is 08.04.2000. In support he has placed reliance on School Leaving Certificate issued by Govt. Boys Sr. Sec. School, DDA Phase-1, Kalkaji, New Delhi issued on 23.08.2002.

4. Considering the plea, let an inquiry be held by the Ld. Trial Court and a report be placed on record.

against him was set aside vide order dated 11.03.2024.
