“a) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction including a writ of certiorari for quashing and setting aside the impugned communication dated 06.01.2026 issued by Respondent No. 2 (National Medical Commission), whereby the application of the Petitioner for issuance of Eligibility Certificate vide



Application ID No. R.15012/030795/2024-Regn has been rejected; and/or

(b) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction including a writ of mandamus directing the Respondents to issue the Eligibility Certificate to the Petitioner in accordance with law; and/or

(c) In the alternative, issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing the Respondents to reconsider the Petitioner's application for issuance of Eligibility Certificate in light of the provisions of the Screening Test Regulations, 2002 and the observations of this Hon'ble Court, within a timebound period; and/or

(d) Pass an interim direction permitting the Respondents to provisionally process the Petitioner's application for Eligibility Certificate or to treat the requirement of Eligibility Certificate as satisfied for the limited purpose of permitting the Petitioner to appear in the FMGE, subject to final outcome of the present petition; and/or"

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.
3. Mr. Chug, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.
1. Mr. Singh, learned standing counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2, seeks and is granted 4 weeks to file a reply.
