This application is for seeking an order of de-sealing of premises No. 1037, Third Floor, Kucha Natwan, Chandni Chowk sealed by the Official Liquidator in compliance of the winding up order dated 28.02.2013 passed in Co. Pet.36/2013.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the Official Liquidator that it was sealed as there was an apprehension that the stock of the company in liquidation was lying in the premises. Since the learned counsel for the applicant submits that they are providing an alternative space for the goods/stock, if any, of the respondent company lying in the premises, so the learned counsel for the Official



Liquidator submits that they would inspect the premises and prepare an inventory thereof and intimate the applicant of the stock and in case the need arises, they would request them to provide space in the premises itself. Learned counsel for the Official Liquidator submits that since the premises in dispute has no relation with the respondent company either as an owner or a tenant, so on providing of the space by the applicant to keep the stock of the company, the remaining portion shall be handed over to the applicant in accordance with law, within two weeks from today.

The application stands disposed of.
