CM APPL. 41653/2026 (For Withdrawal of Vakalatnama)

1. The present application has been filed under Order III Rule 4(2) of the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908 ("CPC") read with Section 151 of the CPC, seeking leave to withdraw their *Vakalatnama*, and for discharge as counsels for the petitioner.
2. It is submitted that upon careful consideration of the matter, the applicants have found that owing to unavoidable professional reasons, they would be unable to continue to appear, act or plead for the petitioner in the present proceedings.



3. Thus, it is submitted that the petitioner *vide* No Objection/Consent Letter dated 04th June, 2026, has expressly consented to the withdrawal of the *Vakalatnama* of the applicants, and confirmed that they have no objection to the applicants being discharged as counsels.

4. The Authorised Representative of the petitioner is present through Video Conferencing (“VC”), and submits that the petitioner shall be engaging a new counsel.

5. Accordingly, considering the submissions made before this Court, leave is granted to Mr. Shailendra Singh, Advocate, *Enrolment no. D/534-A/2001* and Mr. Abhyuday Dhasmana, Advocate, *Enrolment no. D/8088/2022*, to withdraw their *Vakalatnamas* on behalf of the petitioner. The said counsels are discharged from the matter.

6. With the aforesaid directions, the present application is accordingly allowed, and disposed of.
