1. This is a writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking the following prayers :-

“i) By an appropriate writ, order or directions, the respondent may kindly be directed to de-freeze the bank account bearing account No. 02822403000617, being IFSC code PUNB0605800 and Punjab National Bank. Respondent No. 3 bearing account no. 924010070994405, being IFSC code UTIB0001007 and Axis Bank of the petitioner's saving account in respondent bank.

ii) By an appropriate writ, order or directions, the respondent may kindly be directed to not freeze the bank account of the petitioner's in future without prior notice

iii) Any other appropriate order or directions which this



Hon'ble Court deems fit may kindly be passed in favour of the petitioner.

iv) Costs of the writ petition may kindly be awarded in favour of the petitioner.”

2. Mr. Sharma, learned counsel for the petitioner, states that there is no F.I.R. or complaint against the petitioner. Additionally, no reasons have been given for freezing the account of the petitioner and despite the same, the account of the petitioner has been freezed.
3. For the said reasons, issue notice.
4. Mr. Mehrotra, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1 and Mr. Rout, learned Standing Counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent No.2, seeks and is granted 1 week to file a reply.
5. Issue notice to respondent No. 3, through all modes, including electronic, on the petitioner taking steps within one week from today.
6. The police station Cyberabad Police Station, Telangana is impleaded as respondent No. 4.
7. The amended Memo of Parties shall be filed within one week from today.
8. On filing amended Memo of Parties, let notice be issued to newly impleaded respondent No. 4, through all modes, including electronic, on the petitioner taking steps, within one week from filing the amended memo of parties, returnable on 24.03.2026.
