1. Allowed, subject to the appellant filing legible copies of the annexures, at least three (3) days before the next date of hearing.

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2. This appeal seeks to assail the judgment and decree dated 27.09.2023 passed by learned Judge, Family Courts, Dwarka, New Delhi.

2.1 Via the impugned judgment and decree, the petition filed by the appellant seeking divorce under Section 13(1)(ia) and (ib) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 [in short, "HMA"] was dismissed.

3. The record shows that the couple entered matrimony on 17.07.2013. From the wedlock, the couple have one girl-child. The girl-child was born on 30.09.2014.

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4. According to the appellant/husband, the respondent/wife left the matrimonial home on 11.08.2018.
5. According to the counsel for the appellant/husband, serious allegations have been levelled against the family members, who have also been prosecuted criminally.
 - 5.1 It is contended that the accused family members were later discharged in the criminal cases lodged against them.
6. The matter requires further examination.
7. Issue notice to the respondent wife *via* all permissible modes, including email.
8. List the matter on 08.08.2024.
9. Meanwhile, the Registry will summon the record of family court, *albeit*, in digitized form.
