1. It is already 5:15 P.M. The parties have been heard.
2. Learned counsel for the Respondents are directed to file bank statement of the Respondents as on 12.10.2021 till 30.12.2022, details of the Fixed Deposits and mutual funds along with an affidavit. Respondents shall also file an affidavit with respect to the steps proposed to be taken to comply with the repayment obligation under the consent terms. The consent terms record the undertakings of the Respondents, which was taken on record by the Court on 29.10.2021.
3. In the event, the affidavit and the bank statements, details of fixed deposit and mutual funds are not filed within a period of four weeks from



today, the Respondents are directed to remain present in Court on the next date of hearing. In the affidavit, the Respondents will disclose the details of all bank accounts held by them respectively.

4. Learned counsel for the Petitioner states that he has been served with a copy of the reply on behalf of the Respondent No.1, 3, 4 and 5. However, the said reply is not available on Court's record. The Respondent is directed to take steps to bring them on record. The Petitioner shall file its rejoinder, if any, within a period of four weeks from today.

5. Respondent No.2 shall also file his reply within four weeks from today, failing which it will be presumed that he does not have anything to say to the contempt proceedings.
