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1. By this writ petition petitioner seeks setting aside of the impugned order dated 17th December, 2020 passed by respondent No.1 as also directions to respondent No.2 to dispose of the appeal filed against the order dated 12th October, 2020 expeditiously and in the meantime restrain the respondent No.1 from enforcing the impugned order dated 17th December, 2020.

2. The impugned orders are pursuant to the award dated 12th June, 2006 based on a claim filed by Capital Cooperative Thrift and Credit Society Ltd., C.S.C.G.D Block, Pitam Pura, Delhi-110088. Vide the impugned award the petitioner was directed to pay a sum of ₹60,120/-



with interest and penal interest @16% and 3% respectively till realisation in full of the principal sum. The impugned order for recovery of decretal amount has been passed in consequence to the award dated 12th June, 2006. The Capital Cooperative Thrift and Credit Society Ltd. on whose claim the award was passed, has not been impleaded as a party.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks leave to implead Capital Cooperative Thrift and Credit Society Ltd. as party.

4. Amended memo of parties be filed within two days.

5. On the amended memo of parties being filed, issue notice to the newly added respondent Capital Cooperative Thrift and Credit Society Ltd. through email, SMS, whatsapp, speed post and courier, returnable before this Court on 22nd July, 2022.

6. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
