CRL.M.A. 6348/2025 (for modification in the order dated 21.02.2025)

1. Through this application, the Applicant seeks modification of the bail conditions in order dated 21st February, 2025 passed in the present petition. Counsel for the Applicant submits that the Applicant belongs to the poor strata of society and it is difficult for him to arrange for two sureties as directed by this Court. He further submits that the Applicant is suffering from mental ailments, because of which he cannot comply with the condition mentioned in Paragraph No. 4(f) of the said order. In light of the above, counsel for the Applicant requests that the bail conditions be modified accordingly.

2. Considering the above, the conditions in order dated 21st February, 2025 shall stand modified as follows:

“4. Accordingly, the Appellant shall be released on bail, subject to him



furnishing a bail bond in the sum of INR 25,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the concerned Jail Superintendent/Trial Court/ Duty MM on the following conditions:

- (a) The Applicant shall, under no circumstance, leave the NCT of Delhi, without permission of the Trial Court, during the period of his release;*
- (b) The Applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case, in any manner whatsoever;*
- (c) The Applicant shall provide the address where he would be residing after his release and shall not change the address without informing the concerned IO/ SHO;*
- (d) The Applicant shall, upon his release, give his mobile number to the concerned IO/SHO and shall keep his mobile phone switched on at all times.*
- (e) The Applicant shall not commit any offence during the period of his release.”*

3. With the above directions, the present application is disposed of.
