ORDER

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1. The present Petition filed under Section 442 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (formerly Section 397/401 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973) impugns order dated 19th August, 2023, whereby the conviction and sentence of the Petitioner was upheld in relation to FIR No. 31821/2021 registered under Sections 411 and 482 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at P.S. Jamia Nagar.
2. The Petitioner's sentence had been suspended by this Court by order dated 21st February, 2025.
3. Counsel for the Petitioner, on instructions, states that he does not wish to contest the order of conviction and seeks reduction in the period of sentence to the period already undergone.
- 4 In order to explain the mitigating circumstances, a medical record of the Petitioner has been produced, a copy whereof has been provided to Mr.
