1. This is an application filed under Section 151 of the CPC, 1908 seeking the following prayer:

“(a) direct the Respondent to process the pending Application of the Petitioner submitted for closure of its B. Pharm course, during pendency of the captioned Writ Petition; and / or”

2. It is the case of the petitioner that on account of less number of admissions in the B. Pharma course in the petitioner institution, the petitioner does not wish to proceed with the said Course and has already made a representation in this regard to the respondent. The said representation has not been decided so far by the respondent.

3. For the said reasons, issue notice.

4. Mr. Singh, learned counsel accepts notice on behalf of the respondent and states that a No Objection Certificate (**“NOC”**) has not been submitted in this regard by the petitioner.



5. Mr. Sharawat, learned senior counsel for the petitioner, states that the NOC has already been submitted by the petitioner.

6. It is directed that in case there is any other requirement including submission of another copy of the NOC, the respondent may inform the petitioner in writing and the petitioner shall do so within 3 working days of the communication of such requirement by the respondent.

7. The respondent is further directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioner expeditiously and in any case not later than 4 weeks from today.

8. The application is disposed of in aforesaid terms.

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9. Since the prayer in the present petition and the application is the same, in view of the Order passed in CM APPL. 19412/2026, the petition is also disposed of.
