1. Petitioner impugns order dated 27.11.2018, whereby, the appeal of the petitioner, impugning order of the Trial Court dated 02.07.2018, was dismissed. The petitioner was directed to pay maintenance at the rate of Rs. 90,000/- per month from the date of the filing of the application till 20.03.2018 and thereafter at the rate of Rs.1 lakh per month from 20.03.2018 towards maintenance for the respondent as well as the two daughters.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondent admittedly was gainfully employed till 20.03.2018. He submits that

whenever the petitioner used to send money for the maintenance of the daughter towards *inter alia* their school fee, the same was refunded by the mother.

3. Issue notice to the respondent, returnable on 06.05.2019.
4. Subject to the petitioner paying maintenance at the rate of Rs.1 lakh from the date the respondent resigned her services, i.e., 20.03.2018, execution of the impugned order shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. The petitioner shall clear the arrears in two equal instalments, first to be paid within four weeks and the second instalment within four weeks thereafter, in addition to paying the monthly amount of Rs.1 lakh.
