ORDER

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a sum of Rs. 5 lakhs has been paid to the respondent in terms of order dated 06.05.2019. He further submits that the monthly instalment of Rs. One lakh for the month of May, 2019 could not be paid and undertakes that the same shall be paid within a period of one week from today. The undertaking is accepted.

2. Learned counsel for the parties pray that the parties be referred to mediation.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that one meeting before the mediator be fixed for today since the petitioner is coming from Mumbai.

4. Accordingly, the parties are referred to mediation. Parties shall appear before the Delhi High Court Mediation & Conciliation Centre today at 2:15 pm.
5. List before the Court for reporting settlement, if any, on 30.07.2019.
6. At request of learned counsel for the parties, Mr. Sudhanshu Batra, Sr. Advocate is appointed as a mediator to mediate the disputes between the parties.
7. Since the petitioner is a resident of Mumbai, it will be open to the mediator to join the petitioner in mediation proceedings through video conferencing.
8. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that one of the daughters of the parties requires urgent surgery. Learned counsel for the petitioner, under instructions from the petitioner undertakes that the petitioner shall take care of the entire medical expenditure either from medical insurance that he has or from other sources. The undertaking is accepted.
