I.A. 19025/2025 (under Section 151 CPC seeking leave to place on record Compact Discs (CDs) by plaintiffs)

1. By way of present application the plaintiffs seeks to place on record Compact Disc (CD) containing audio/video recordings, the transcript of which is already on record as Document-23.
2. Mr. Pankaj Vivek, learned counsel appearing on behalf of defendants submits that there is a possibility that the transcript which has been placed on record might be at variance with what is recorded in the CD. If that be so, the defendants will be at liberty to file true transcript of the said CD.
3. Having regard to the fact that the transcript of the recordings in the CD filed by the plaintiff is already on record, the present application is allowed reserving the liberty to the defendants to cross examine the plaintiffs' witness on the contents of the CD.



4. Further, defendants are also at liberty to place their own version of the transcript, which according to them is true copy of the recordings in the CD, and prove the same in accordance with law.
5. The application is disposed of.
