5. The petitioner has filed this petition with the following prayers:-

“a) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorari, or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing and setting aside the award of contract pursuant to the NIT bearing No. TCIL/78/2025/DT/Elderline dated 28.07.2025 in favour of Respondent No. 2, namely Vision Plus Security Control Limited, being arbitrary, nontransparent, and vitiated by illegal alteration of eligibility criteria;

b) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order or direction,



directing the Respondent No.1 to re-float the NIT bearing no.TCIL/78/2025/DT/ELDERLINE to ensure adequate competition and proper price discovery;

c) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus quashing the disqualification of the Petitioner by the Respondent No. 1 under the clause 1.2 (d) of the NIT bearing No. TCIL/78/2025/DT/Elderline dated 28.07.2025;

d) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus restraining Respondent No. 1 from invoking or encashing the Earnest Money Deposit submitted by Cyfuture India Private Limited by way of Bank Guarantee bearing No. 088GT02252390007 given through Respondent No. 3, and further direct Respondent No. 1 to release and return the said Bank Guarantee and refund the Earnest Money Deposit to Petitioner

In the alternative of prayer (a), (b), (c) and (d)

(d1) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorari, or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing and setting aside Corrigendum No. 9 dated 01.10.2025 issued by Respondent No. 1, namely Telecommunications Consultants India Limited, insofar as it arbitrarily and unlawfully amends Clause 1.2(g)(iii) of the NIT bearing No. TCIL/78/2025/DT/Elderline dated 28.07.2025, after commencement of the tender process;

(d2) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Mandamus, directing Respondent No. 1 to restore the Petitioner's eligibility and consider the Petitioner for participation in the tender process in accordance with the original terms and conditions of the NIT, without giving effect to the impugned Corrigendum No. 9;

e) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorari, or any other appropriate writ, order or direction, quashing and setting aside the impugned Show Cause Notice dated 29.01.2026 issued by Respondent No.1;

f) Issue an appropriate writ, order or direction directing constitution of an independent committee, under the supervision of this Hon'ble Court or any other appropriate authority, to conduct an impartial investigation into the present tender process as well as the collusion involving the Respondent No. 1 and 2.

g) Pass such other or further order(s) as this Hon'ble Court may



deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

6. Issue notice. Ms Ritika Priya, learned counsel for the respondent no.1 accepts notice and seeks time to file counter affidavit. Notice be issued to the respondents no.2 & 3 through all permissible modes, returnable on the next date of hearing. On receipt of notice the respondents no.2 & 3 may also file the counter affidavit, if any, before the next date of hearing.

7. Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, we take on record the submission of the learned counsel for the respondent no.1 that the bank guarantee as furnished by the petitioner shall not be invoked till the next date of hearing. We also direct that the respondent no.1 shall not take any coercive steps, including blacklisting the petitioner, till the next date of hearing.

8. The counter affidavit be filed by respondent no.1 within a period of 15 days from today. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be also filed within 05 days thereafter.

9. Renotify on 23.03.2026.
