1. The matter is listed today for further cross-examination of PW-1 Mrs. Shanti Bhagat.
2. As per office noting, no document has been filed in compliance of order dated 04.02.2025.
3. Perusal of order dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court in IA No.5942/2025 would show that documents filed on behalf of the defendant vide diary no.436996/2019 have been taken on record. However, neither soft copy nor hard copy of the above said documents of defendants are no record.

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4. Ld. Counsel for defendants has submitted that the said documents were already filed vide diary no.436996/2019



dated 10.5.2019. He has further submitted that the said documents were allowed to be taken on record vide order dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court. In view of the same, let report be called from Registry as to why the said documents, which were allowed to be taken on record vide order dated 05.03.2025 passed by the Hon'ble Court, are not available either in soft copy or hard copy of judicial record.

Counsel for plaintiff has submitted that two witnesses of the plaintiff are available today and the matter is being adjourned as the said documents are not available on record, which was the duty of the defendants to bring them on record. 7. In the meantime, the defendants are also directed to take appropriate steps for getting their documents on record as per Rules.
