Advance copy of the IA has been supplied to learned counsel for plaintiff but none has appeared for the plaintiff. By way of this IA, the defendants No.1to6 seek direction to the plaintiff to supply the documents as detailed in para 5 of the IA. Learned counsel for defendants No.1to6 has shown the documents supplied to the defendants with the summons. Photocopies of the photographs were sent to the defendants which are not clear. Defendants tried to have certified copies but they were not supplied due to reasons mentioned in the IA. IA is allowed. Plaintiff is directed to appear in the court on the next date with proper copies of the documents so that same can be supplied to the defendants. Learned counsel for defendants No.1to6 submits that the time taken for supplying the copies of the documents by the plaintiff should be excluded from the period for filing the written statement. This submission will be considered on the next date.
