Reply filed. Heard.

By way of present IA D-1 to 6 have sought direction for D-8 to 9 to discover/produce on oath the documents mentioned in para no.3 of IA i.e.gift deed & revenue record.

On specific query of court as to whether copy of gift deed mentioned in para no.3 of the IA is in possession of D-8 & 9 or not it is submitted by learned counsel for D-8 & 9 that copy of this gift deed is not in possession of D-8 & 9.

Learned counsel for D-8 & 9 submits that in revenue record gift

deed has been mentioned.

Learned counsel for D-1 to 6 submits that she is unable to read the contents of document since they are in Urdu.

At this stage learned counsel for D-1 to 6 submits that D-8 & 9 are required to be directed to produce translated copy of documents supplied to her as same are in Urdu. Since this application involves only discovery and production of documents, hence in my opinion D-8 & 9 cannot be directed to produce translated copy of documents.

In so far as discovery / production on oath of the documents mentioned in para no.3 are concerned same has been discovered and produced as copy of the available documents has been given to learned counsel for D-1 to 6.

In view of above observation, there is no need to issue any direction.

This application is accordingly disposed off.
