3. Present petition has been filed under section 482 Cr.P.C. read with Article 227 of Constitution of India to set aside order dated 25.01.2021 passed by learned ACMM-01 (Central), Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi and also seeks quashing of FIR No.159/1999 registered at Police Station Kashmere Gate for the offences punishable under sections 420/468/471/120-B IPC in CR No.287418/2016.
4. Present petition is filed on the ground that respondent

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no.2/complainant was inducted as partner by his father when he was a minor. Father used to send cycle parts to respondent no.2 which he used to further sell. On 31.03.1992, respondent no.2 signed the dissolution deed of M/s Kapoor Sons & Co. and on 01.04.1992, respondent no.2 also signed on partnership deeds of Ropas International and Continental films.

5. First Closure Report was filed on 26.11.1999. Thereafter second closure Report was filed on 01.03.2001 and third on 02.02.2002, however, Trial Court took cognizance of offences as he didnot agree with the closure Reports filed .

6. Notice issued.

7. Learned APP for State and counsel for respondent no.2 accept notice and seek time to file status report and reply respectively.

8. Let needful be done within 2 weeks with an advance copy to the other side.

9. Response thereto, if any, be filed within one week thereafter.

10. Renotify on 26.03.2021.

11. Till further order, proceedings against the petitioner before the Trial Court shall remain stayed.
