3. An Application has been filed on behalf of the Petitioner seeking Stay of the operation of the Order dated 19.12.2024 passed by the learned Trial Court in Complaint Case No.63/1/11.

4. Learned M.M vide Order dated 19.12.2024 as allowed the exemption Application filed on behalf of the accused persons for the given date and the matter has been adjourned for 17.05.2025.

5. There is nothing in the Order which needs to be stayed for which the Application has been filed.

6. Learned counsel for the Petitioner has vehemently argued time and again despite being told number of times, that it may be recorded that he has a right to move an Exemption Application before the learned M.M on the next date.
