1. Issue notice. Learned counsel for the decree holder accepts notice.
2. The judgment debtors are seeking recall of the order dated 27th November, 2019 insofar as the judgment debtors have been directed to be detained in civil prison for three months. It is submitted that the judgment debtors have filed the affidavit of assets along with the application.
3. Learned counsel for the decree holder submits that the affidavits filed by the judgment debtor are deficient. Learned counsel for the judgment debtors submits that the judgment debtors shall file fresh affidavits within ten days.
4. In the interest of justice, ten days time is granted to the judgment debtors to file fresh affidavit of assets on the date of the cause of action, date of the award as well as on the date of the affidavit in Form 16A, Appendix E under Order XXI Rule 41(2) of the Code of Civil Procedure within ten days.
5. The judgment debtors are directed to file an additional affidavit in the



format attached hereto as ***Annexure-A*** to the judgment dated 05th December, 2019 in ***M/s Bhandari Engineers Builders Pvt. Ltd. v. M/s Maharia Raj Joint Venture*** in EX.P. 275/2012 along with documents mentioned therein within ten days.

6. Paragraphs No.5 to 7 of the order dated 27th November, 2019 are kept in abeyance till the next date of hearing.
7. List on 07th January, 2020, date already fixed.
8. The judgment debtors shall remain present in Court on the next date of hearing.
9. Copy of this order be given *dasti* to counsels for the parties under signature of Court Master.
