1. The appellant/husband is aggrieved by the judgment dated 11.11.2019 passed by the learned Family Court, East District, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, dismissing the petition filed by him for dissolution of his marriage with the respondent/wife on the grounds of cruelty and desertion.
2. Mr. Murari Tiwari, learned counsel for the appellant states, on instructions from his client that for the present, notice may not be issued in the present appeal and only a limited notice be issued to the respondent for exploring the possibility of the parties arriving at a negotiated settlement.

Accordingly, while keeping aside the merits of the present appeal for the present, limited notice is issued to the respondent directly, as also through counsel appearing for her before the Family Court, for exploring the possibility of the parties arriving at a negotiated settlement. Process fee be filed by the appellant for effecting service on the respondent by speed post and courier, returnable on 22.04.2020.
