I.A.No.27048/2025 (under Section 151 CPC filed on behalf of the plaintiffs for condoning the delay in filing of replication and admission/denial of documents)

1. As per office note, reply to the captioned IA has been filed on behalf of defendant no.1.
2. Reply to the captioned IA filed on behalf of defendant no.2 has been returned under objection.
3. By way of captioned IA, the plaintiff prays for condonation of delay of 42 days in filing replication and affidavit of admission/denial.
4. Learned counsels appearing on behalf of defendant nos.1 & 2 have strongly opposed the captioned IA and submit that the application is liable to be dismissed as there is a delay of more than 45 days in filing the



replication.

5. Heard. Record perused.
6. Perusal of record shows that the defendant nos.1 & 2 have filed their written statements on 30.07.2025 & 12.08.2025 respectively and the plaintiff has filed replications for the first time on 10.10.2025 which were returned under objection and re-filed the same on 24.10.2025. In view of the aforesaid, it shows that the plaintiff has filed replications even after the expiry of more than 45 days and for the said reason, replication cannot be taken on record. Accordingly, the captioned IA is dismissed.
7. IA stands disposed of.

8. Right of the plaintiff to file replication qua the written statements of defendant no.1 & 2 is closed.
9. The matter is at the stage of admission/denial of documents.
