1. This application is filed by the petitioners seeking a direction against the respondent to energise the electricity connection of the premise in question pursuant to two applications filed by the petitioners for domestic connection on the first and second floor of the property of the petitioners.
2. It appears that respondent claims a sum of Rs.25,00,000/- approximately as outstanding on account of old dues. This Court on 29.01.2019 had stayed the disconnection of electricity, subject to the petitioner depositing Rs.5 lakhs in Court. Learned counsel for respondent states that unless the balance amount is paid, fresh connection which has been applied for by the petitioner cannot be energised.
3. The outstanding claim made by the respondent has yet to be adjudicated. In the interest of justice, subject to further orders of this Court, let respondent energise the domestic connection subject to payment of Rs.4 lakhs to the respondent alongwith all other commercial formalities.
