The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with the following prayer:

“a. Issue a writ, order, directions in nature of mandamus to direct the Respondent No. 1 to allow the Petitioner an option of cancellation of her provisional allotment made in the All India Quota (hereinafter “AIQ”) stray round of NEET-PG 2024 counselling (hereinafter “stray round”) in view of the inadvertent and bonafide mistake done by her while filling the choice;

b. Issue a writ, order, directions in nature of mandamus to direct the Respondent No. 1 to allow the Petitioner in the facts and circumstances of the present case to appear in NEET-PG 2025;

c. Issue a writ, order, directions in nature of mandamus to direct the Respondent No. 1 to consider the prayer made by



the Petitioner in her representation dated 20.02.2025 regarding cancellation of her provisional allotment made in the All India Quota (hereinafter “AIQ”) stray round of NEET-PG 2024 counselling (hereinafter “stray round”) and a request regarding permission to participate in NEET-PG 2025, in view of the inadvertent and bonafide mistake made by her while filling the choice;

d. Issue a writ, order, directions in nature of mandamus to direct the Respondent No. 1 to allow the Petitioner with an option of cancellation of the allotted seat in AIQ and consequently allow the Petitioner with an option to participate in the state stray round of counselling, in order to ensure that entire year of the Petitioner is not wasted;

e. Pass such other further order(s) as this Hon’ble Court deems fit and proper, under the facts and circumstances of the case and in the interest of justice.”

Issue notice to the respondents through all permissible modes, returnable on 25.02.2025.
