1. As per office note, Replication alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by plaintiff qua LRs of D-1 is on record.

2. As per office note, fresh Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by LR no.3 of deceased defendant no.1 is on record. However, it be noted that Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents has already been filed by defendant no.1 prior to his death and no new documents has been filed by the plaintiff after the death of defendant no.1. At this stage, learned counsel for LRs of D-1 seeks permission to withdraw aforesaid Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by LR no.3 of D-1. Allowed.

4. At this stage, it is noticed that the Affidavits of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by deceased defendant no.1 as well as by LR no.3 of D-1 are not in the prescribed format. So, LRs of D-1 is directed to file fresh/proper Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents as per Chapter VII of Delhi High Court (Original Side) Rules within two weeks with copy to the



opposite side.

5. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents with learned counsel for the defendants within two weeks. Learned respective counsel for defendants are directed to provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within one week thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents compatible with fresh Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by LR of D-1 at least two weeks before the next date of hearing.

6. Parties are directed to file hard copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record, if not filed earlier before the next date of hearing.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 05.03.2025.
