1. As per office note, Replication alongwith Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by plaintiff qua LR of D-1 is on record.
2. Learned counsel for LR of D-1 undertakes to pay previous cost of Rs.3000/- as imposed vide order dated 05.03.2025 to the plaintiff on the next date of hearing.
3. As per office not, respective Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by LR no.(i)&(iii) and LR no.(ii) of deceased defendant no.1 are on record. However, on perusal of the same, it is found that the same are having bare denials and thus are not strictly as per law. In the interest of justice and subject to imposition of cost of Rs.1000/- upon LR of D-1, the last and final opportunity is granted to LR of D-1 to file revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents strictly as per law within three weeks (failing which the exemplary cost would be imposed), with copy to the opposite side.
4. Thereafter, the plaintiff is directed to share draft of Joint Schedule of the documents as compatible with the



revised Affidavit of Admission/Denial of the documents filed by LR's of D-1 with learned counsel for the defendants within two weeks. Learned respective counsel for defendants are directed to provide their inputs, if any, to the draft of Joint Schedule of the documents to learned counsel for the plaintiff within ten days thereafter. The plaintiff is directed to file soft copy as well as physical copy of Joint Schedule of the documents within two weeks with copy to the opposite side.

5. The parties have not filed the hard copy of the documents of which e-copy already filed on record. In the interest of justice, last and final opportunity is granted to the parties to file the same within three weeks, failing which the defaulting party will deposit cost of Rs.2000/- with Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee.

Re-notify the matter for marking of exhibits to the documents on 03.09.2025.
