“a) Issue a Writ of Mandamus and Direct the Respondent No. 1 & 2 to issue Certificate of verification from the “OnLine Teacher Registration Management System (OTRMS)” to the Petitioner for him completing his B.Ed Course in 2023 from Respondent No.4’s recognized



*institution as the “Delhi Institute of Rural Development”;
and*

*b) Issue a Writ of Mandamus and direct the Respondent No.1 & 2 to carry out necessary changes on the website of the NCTE at “Online Teacher Registration Management System ” [OTRMS] and to reflect the name of the Respondent no.4 ’ s institution as “Delhi Institute of Rural Development ” in place of “ Delhi College of Education”;
and*

c) In alternative to Prayers (a) to (b) above and without prejudice, issue a Writ of Mandamus and direct the Respondent No.3 and 4 to issue fresh degrees and consolidated mark sheets to the Petitioner, who has passed out B.Ed Course (in July, 2023) from Respondent No.4’s Institute by incorporating the name of the Respondent no. 4’s institute as “Delhi College of Education” in place of “Delhi Institute of Rural Development”...”

2. For the reasons stated in the petition, issue notice.
3. Ms. Malhotra, learned counsel accepts notice for respondent Nos. 1 and 2, Ms. Sahani, learned counsel accepts notice for respondent No. 3 and Mr. Kant, learned counsel accepts notice for respondent No. 4. They seek and are granted time to obtain instructions.
