The court appointed valuer has reported that the parties have in fact mostly not cooperated with him in valuing the properties. Only a portion of the fee fixed has been paid.

Defendant no.2(a) and (b) have moved this application seeking variation of the order. It is unfortunate that there has been complete non-cooperation by Defendant nos. 2(a) and (b).

Considering the overall circumstances, defendant No.8(c) and Defendant Nos.2(a) and (b) to now pay Rs.10,000/- each to the valuer. The inspection by the valuer of the Nizamuddin East shall take place on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2019. Let the report be filed within one week thereafter.
