 - III. The original record with regard to Smt.Saroj Khanna being made a nominee in the fixed deposits of Sh.Rajesh Kumar Khanna shall be produced by the defendant no.1 Bank on the next date of hearing and a copy thereof shall be filed.
 - IV. Defendant no.1 Bank shall place before the Court all correspondence, documents, indemnity bond, surety etc. that have been filed by the defendant no.3 and/or defendant no.4 with the defendant no.1 bank to claim amounts lying in the bank accounts and Fixed Deposits of Sh.Rajesh Kumar Khanna.
9. The application stands disposed of.
