(suspension of sentence)

1. The present application is filed under Section 397(1) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (**CrPC**) seeking suspension of sentence dated 05.06.2023 and grant of bail to the petitioner.
2. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the fine imposed by the learned Trial Court has already been deposited.
3. He submits that since the petitioner belongs to poor strata of society, he would require further four weeks' time to pay the compensation amount to the injured and the family of the deceased.
4. He requests for grant of interim bail for a period of four weeks.
5. Considering the aforesaid fact, the petitioner is admitted on interim bail for a period of four weeks from date, on furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹20,000/- with one surety of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Trial



Court/Duty MM/Link MM, on the following conditions:

- a. The petitioner / applicant shall upon his release provide his mobile number to the IO/SHO;
 - b. The petitioner / applicant shall inform his address, where he would be residing after his release to the IO/SHO;
 - c. The petitioner / applicant shall not leave the country without the permission of the learned Trial Court;
 - d. The petitioner / applicant shall surrender before the jail authorities on expiry of four weeks from the date of his release.
