1. Learned counsel for the parties submit that the first instalment of Rs.30,000/- has already been received by the petitioner no.1 in compliance of the earlier order.
2. Respondent, who is present in person, has handed over a Demand Draft of Rs.30,000/- dated 22.12.2025 bearing number 382824 drawn on Kotak Mahindra Bank, in favour of the petitioner no.1 to the learned counsel for the petitioners as second instalment.
3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent appearing through video conferencing seeks, and is granted, a period of two weeks for coming with a timeline/ schedule to clear the pending dues, if any.
