1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner, praying for a direction to the respondents to grant disability element of pension to the petitioner.

2. It is the case of the petitioner that the petitioner joined the BSF in the rank of Mahila Constable/General Duty in the year 2013. In a Medical Board Examination conducted on 27.10.2023, she was diagnosed with Schizophrenia. The Medical Board opined that the condition was aggravated by service condition, and the disability was determined as 40% permanent disability. Following the issuance of a Show Cause Notice, she was invalidated from service on 25.04.2024.



3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite a considerable period having been passed, the petitioner has not been paid the disability or service element of the pension.
4. Issue notice.
5. Notice is accepted by Mr.R Venkat Prabhat, the learned counsel on behalf of the respondents. He prays for and is granted two weeks' time to seek instructions and file a counter affidavit, if required. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within a period of two weeks thereafter.
