I.A. 2561/2021 (Exemption)

2. Plaint be registered as suit.
3. Issue summons in the suit and notice in the application to the defendants on the plaintiffs taking steps through speed post, courier as well as through WhatsApp and E-mail returnable before the learned Joint Registrar on 06.04.2021 for completion of service, pleadings and admission/denial of documents.
4. The summons shall indicate that the written statements to the suit and reply affidavits to the application must be filed by the defendants within thirty days from the date of receipt of the summons. The defendants shall also file affidavits of admission/denial of the documents filed by the plaintiffs, failing which the written statements shall not be taken on record.
5. The plaintiffs are at liberty to file replications and rejoinder affidavits thereto within three weeks after filing of the written statements. The replications shall be accompanied by affidavits of admission/denial in



respect of the documents filed by the defendants, failing which the replications shall not be taken on record.\

6. List the suit and the application before the Court on 07.05.2021.
