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1. This Court by an Order dated 16.04.2025 passed the following directions:

- “1. Learned Counsel for the Appellant requests for an adjournment.
2. The order dated 07.08.2024 has not been complied with by the Appellant.
3. The request for adjournment is opposed by the learned Counsel for the Respondents. She submits that multiple adjournments have been taken and opportunities have been sought by the Appellant for complying with the orders of this Court.
4. The concerned official of the Appellant shall remain physically present before Court on the next date of hearing.”

2. The only ground that has been raised in the present Appeal by the Appellant is on contributory negligence of the deceased.

3. Learned Counsel appearing on behalf of the Appellant once again requests for an adjournment. The record also reflects that the orders dated 16.04.2025 and 07.08.2024 have not been complied with by the Appellant.



3.1 The request for adjournment is opposed by the learned Counsel for the Respondent Nos. 1 to 4/Claimants. He submits that the matter is being delayed and has been pending since 2019.

4. The adjournment is granted, subject to the payment of costs in the sum of Rs. 15,000/- to be paid to the Respondent within a week from today.

5. The Registry is directed to bookmark the digital copy of the Trial Court Record received in accordance with the rules of the High Court.

7. The parties will act based on the digitally signed copy of the order.
