Since the appellant's sentence has already been suspended vide order dated 16.01.2023, the present applications seeking interim suspension of sentence have become infructuous and are disposed of as such.

**CRL.A. 133/2019**

1. Mr. M. L. Yadav, learned counsel, states that he has no instructions to appear as the appellant has not contacted him since his release from jail after the suspension of his sentence. He seeks discharge. Ordered accordingly.
2. Mr. Kanhaiya Lal Singhal, learned counsel, states that he has been appointed by the DHCLSC to represent the appellant in the present appeal.
3. Issue Court Notice (without process fees) to the appellant, returnable on the next date of hearing.

Ashish Mishra, reported as **(2022) 9 SCC 321**, and if required, shall assist the complainant in approaching the Secretary, Delhi High Court Legal Services Committee, who may appoint a panel counsel, if so requested. The I.O. shall also supply a copy of the paper book to the complainant, as well as to the counsel, if so appointed.
