1. This is a writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950, seeking *inter alia* the following reliefs:-

“In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, it is thus most respectfully prayed that Your Lordships may kindly be pleased to issue a Writ, Order or Direction;

(i) Quashing the Order dated 18.6.2022, issued by the Respondent Bank (Annexure-P/10).

(ii) Directing the Respondent Bank to compute and pay the dues of Halting Allowance to the Petitioner from 11.3.2014 to 8.6.2020, during his overstayed deputation at Delhi;

(iii) Directing payment of Interest on the aforesaid dues till date and pendentelite interest @12% pa;

(iv) Pass any other or further order or direction which the Hon'ble Court may deem fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case.”



2. Issue notice.
3. Notice is accepted by Mr. Akshit Kapur, learned counsel appearing for the respondent - Bank, who seeks and is granted four weeks time to file the counter affidavit. Rejoinder thereto, if any, be filed within four weeks thereafter.
