Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, while drawing the attention of this court to the impugned communication dated 27.02.2023 (Annexure-P/2) states that the provisional admission of the petitioner has been cancelled to the M.V.Sc. degree course for the Academic Year 2022-23 solely on the ground that the institution from where the petitioner did his



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graduation course, was not accredited to respondent No.2.- the Indian Council for Agricultural Research (in short, ICAR).

5. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, while drawing the attention of this court to order dated 20.02.2023 passed in W.P. (C) No. 17420/2022 and other connected matters, states that this court by the said interim order has already taken a view that the power to regulate the standard of education in veterinary courses lies with respondent No.3- the Veterinary Council of India, under the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984, and therefore, the accreditation by respondent No.2-ICAR should not be the reason for cancellation of admission of the petitioner.

6. Having perused the material available on record, this court *prima facie* finds that the matter requires to be considered after giving an appropriate opportunity of hearing to the respondents.

7. Issue notice.

8. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent Nos. 1 and 3, accepts notice.

9. Let notice be also issued to respondent Nos. 2 and 4 on taking of steps by the petitioner through all permissible modes, returnable on 07.07.2023.

10. Subject to hearing the respondents, there shall be a stay of the operation of the impugned order dated 27.02.2023 (Annexure-P/2).

11. Order *dasti*.
