CRL.REV.P.(NI) 60/2025, CRL.M.(BAIL) 460/2025 (for suspension of sentence) & CRL.M.A. 9346/2025 (for release of the DD amount)

1. This application has been filed by respondent no.2/complainant. Learned counsel for revisionist/convict submits that he has no objection to this application. As submitted by both sides, out of Rs. 6,00,000/- towards compensation, a sum of Rs. 1,20,000/- was deposited with the appellate court by the revisionist and that amount has already been released to the respondent no.2. Further in terms with order dated 03.03.2025 of the predecessor bench, Rs. 1,80,000/- was deposited by the revisionist with Registry of this Court and it is for release thereof that this application has been filed.

2. The present application makes two prayers, namely release of the



amount already deposited and grant of further protection only subject to payment of the entire balance compensation amount of Rs. 3,00,000/-.

3. So far as release of Rs. 1,80,000/- is concerned, in view of no objection from the side of revisionist, the said request is allowed and the matter be placed before Registrar General for the release on 15.04.2026.

4. But so far as the payment of the remaining Rs. 3,00,000/-, learned counsel for respondent no.2 submits that the interim protection subject to deposit of 50% compensation amount was only till next date vide order dated 03.03.2025 and since none appeared for the revisionist on 01.12.2025 and the predecessor bench issued default notice, the said interim protection stands vacated and now it is up to this Court to grant interim protection or not.

5. As regards the balance amount of Rs. 3,00,000/-, learned counsel for revisionist seeks adjournment to take instructions.

6. As requested, relist on 13.07.2026 in Advance List, but it is made clear that there is no interim protection from arrest of the revisionist.
