1. By this application appellant seeks interim suspension of sentence on the ground that 'barsi' of his mother is to be performed on 29th July, 2022.
2. Status report has been handed over as per which the mother of appellant passed away on 25th September, 2021 and her 'barsi' is being organized by her elder son Ranjeet Singh at Gurdwara Shri Guru Singh Sabha, Abchal Nagar, Nilothi Extn, New Delhi from 29th July, 2022 to 31st July, 2022.
3. Statements in this regard have been examined and nominal roll has been received. During the pendency of the present appeal, sentence of the appellant was suspended for a period of one month with effect from 19th October, 2021 to 19th November, 2021, however, the appellant surrendered 6



days after expiry of period of suspension of sentence.

4. Considering the fact that 'barsi' of appellant's mother is fixed from 19th October, 2021 to 19th November, 2021, this Court deems it fit to grant interim suspension of sentence for a period of 4 weeks from the date of his release, subject to furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹25,000 with 2 sureties of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Trial Court / CMM/Duty Magistrate and one of the sureties will be family member of the appellant. Appellant shall also give the mobile number which will be used by him during the period of suspension of sentence so that he can be contacted as and when required.
5. Status report handed over to this Court has been returned to the learned APP who will e-file the same.
6. Application is disposed of.
7. Order be uploaded on the website of this Court.
