ORDER

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28.02.2025

1. This matter pertains to year 2020. However, financial status report in respect of applicant is yet to be obtained from the concerned SDM.
2. Notice could not be issued to concerned SDM to make enquiry as regards the financial status of the applicant as PF was not filed.
3. Applicant-Subhash Chandra Kumra, appearing in person, submits that he has not been able to contact his counsel for the last two months.
4. Applicant contacted his counsel-Mr. P.K. Saxena on his mobile number i.e. 9810015178 in court but he did not respond.
5. Appellant has furnished his mobile number as well as residential address, which is as under:-

6. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that he has not received copy of paper-book.
7. Subject to filing vakalatnama by learned counsel for the respondent, soft copy of complete paper-book be supplied by the Registry within a week.
8. Reply be filed within four weeks thereafter.
9. Rejoinder, if any, be filed within four weeks thereafter.
10. As recorded in the last order, applicant is still residing alone in Vrindavan.
11. Applicant is not willing to disclose his address of Vrindavan and has furnished the incomplete address of Vrindavan, which is as under:-

12. During the proceedings, applicant has provided the mobile number of his son-Mr. Gaurav (8929861331), which is different from the one provided on 29.04.2024..
13. On contacting Mr. Gaurav in court, he has disclosed that his father/applicant is not residing at his Delhi address mentioned in para 5 above. However, Mr. Gaurav has furnished another residential address of applicant, which is as under:-

14. In view of the above, it is evident that applicant is not cooperating and deliberately delaying the matter.
15. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that applicant is adopting the delaying tactics and has transferred his all assets in favour of his son during the pendency of this matter.
16. Let court notice be issued to concerned SDM at Delhi and Ghaziabad to submit his report with respect to financial status of the applicant including following aspects:-
- a. when the property situated at Dilshad Garden along with business was transferred by applicant in favour of his son.
 - b. total income being generated out of business transferred by applicant in favour of his son.
 - c. paras 6(i to iii) of Order dated 29.04.2024.
17. Applicant is directed to remain present along with his counsel on the next date of hearing.
18. Re-notify on 13.05.2025.
