The hearing has been conducted through hybrid mode (physical and virtual hearing).

1. The learned counsel for the parties state, upon instructions, that an endeavour could well be made to settle the *lis* amicably, especially since one of the siblings who lives overseas is likely to visit India shortly. The disposition of the parties to resolve the disputes amicably, in the best possible manner, is *ex facie* prudent.
2. In the interim, the parties will endeavour to resolve the disputes without pursuing the litigation.
3. The learned Senior Advocate for the plaintiff submits that the plaintiff will render all the assistance in this regard.



4. At joint request, list on 19.07.2022.
5. Till then, the parties assure the court that no third party interest shall be created in the estate of the mother.
6. Defendant Nos. 2 and 3 state that there is a Will of the mother. A copy of the Will referred to in the communication between the parties has been supplied to the learned Senior Advocate for the plaintiff during the proceedings.
7. The learned counsel for the plaintiff submits that assistance and guidance of the family elders also may be sought, as the same may go a long way in resolving the issues.
