**ORDER**

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**21.07.2022**

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that SLP (Crl.) 5743/2022 had been preferred on behalf of the petitioner against the order dated 10.05.2022 passed in Crl.M.A.9058/2022.

The operative portion of the order dated 18.07.2022 passed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court may be reproduced for ready reference:

*"...We have taken the statements of the learned senior counsel for the parties on record. It will be open to the High Court/trial court to examine the mirror/clone copy which has been enclosed with the charge-sheet and to ensure that the personal information or data which do not pertain and relate to the charge-sheet are not made available to any third person including the informant/complainant. It will also be the duty of*



*respondent No.2 to ensure that he does not use or disclose any personal information or data.*

*Recording the aforesaid, the petition for special leave to appeal is disposed of.”*

I am of the considered view that in the light of the aforesaid directions petitioner is at liberty to approach the learned trial court for seeking requisite compliance of aforesaid directions.

Further time is sought on behalf of respondent No. 2 to file reply. Let the same be filed within a period of four weeks with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Rejoinder, if any, be filed thereafter by petitioner within a period of four weeks with an advance copy to learned counsel for the petitioner.

A copy of status report has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, as prayed.
