1. This hearing has been done through hybrid mode.
2. The Petitioner, who is a Canadian citizen, by way of the present petition seeks issuance of an exit visa by the Respondent- Foreign Regional Registration Officer in order to enable him to attend to his father's medical requirements in the U.S. As per the Petitioner, he has been staying in India over a matrimonial dispute with his wife since 2015.
3. Reply has been filed by the Respondent. Let the rejoinder be filed by the Petitioner within 4 weeks. Along with rejoinder, the following information shall also be furnished by the Petitioner to the Court:
 - i. Complete order sheet in the domestic violence case filed by the Petitioner's wife and pending before the Trial Court in Mumbai.



- ii. Details of the assets which can be furnished as security by the Petitioner.
 - iii. If there are any orders passed by any court directing payment of maintenance to the wife and to the children and, if so, the relevant order sheets.
4. The Petitioner is again given liberty to seek a no objection for his travel from the Trial Court in Mumbai where the domestic violence case is pending.
5. If the order of the Trial Court in Mumbai is passed giving no objection to the Petitioner to travel, the Petitioner is permitted to approach this Court by way of an application.
