1. This petition has been filed challenging the dismissal of Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C. application filed by complainant/petitioner.
2. Dismissal was on the account that the allegations are within the purview of Prevention of Corruption Act and the SC/ST Act and, therefore, could only be adjudicated by Magistrate empowered under Section 190 of Cr.P.C. to take cognizance.
3. Counsel for petitioner states that the issue may arise at the stage of cognizance, not at the stage of entertaining an application under Section 156 (3) Cr.P.C.
4. APP, however, states that he shall examine the law in this regard and submits that sanction would be required considering that accused persons are police officials.
