1. It is a disposed of matter.
2. The Court has seen its earlier order dated 23.03.2026.
3. During course of arguments, learned counsel for applicant submits that an email has already been sent to Jail Authorities on 29.06.2026 which is yet not disposed of. She submits that limited request of the applicant herein is to permit her regular and more frequent telephonic and video call communication with her minor daughter. She submits that presently, she is permitted to communicate with her daughter, only once a week.
4. Learned Addl. Standing Counsel for State submit that if any such representation is pending, it will be ensured that same is considered without any further delay and outcome is duly communicated to the applicant as well as her counsel on her given email ID.

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5. At this juncture, learned counsel for applicant does not press for any further relief. She, however, submits that if the outcome is adverse to the interest of the applicant, she may be granted to liberty to take appropriate judicial remedy, in accordance with law.
6. Application is accordingly disposed of as not pressed.
7. Liberty, as prayed for, is granted.
